

INSTALLATION GUIDE

Vinyl Window & Door Decals

Use this guide to properly install your CSS window and door decals, which are produced using printed 5-mil, cast PVC reflective vinyl.

3-STEP EASY INSTALLATION:

STEP ONE: PREP YOUR SURFACE

Surfaces to which the material will be applied must be thoroughly cleaned from dust, grease or any contamination which could affect the adhesion of the material. Freshly lacquered or painted surfaces should be allowed to dry for at least three weeks and to completely cure. The compatibility of selected lacquers and paints should be tested by the user, prior to application of the material. The self-adhesive reflective material can only be used for dry application. DO NOT apply vinyl to a wet surface.

STEP TWO: PREP YOUR TOOL KIT

Your tools-on-hand should include:

1. **A Tape Measure**
2. **A Soft-sided Squeegee** or a Felt Vinyl Applicator***
3. **A Marking Pencil***

STEP THREE: VINYL APPLICATION

1. **MEASURE & MARK:** Hold your decal (with backing paper still attached) and find your desired placement. Mark along the bottom center of the decal with your marking pencil. Using your tape measure, measure down to your mark. Using this measurement as a guide, measure and make tick marks to the left and right of your first marking. Double-check your work to make sure you've created a straight baseline for your decal.

More experienced users may opt to "eyeball" decals in place and skip the marking procedure described above. the repositionable cast PVC reflective vinyl allows for some repositioning before the decal is squeegeed into place but please use caution when doing so.

2. **PEEL & PLACE:** Peel your decal away from the backing sheet & align the bottom edge of the decal with your tick marks.

3. **SMOOTH WITH A SQUEEGEE:** Using a soft-sided or felt squeegee, firmly smooth down the decal, starting from the center and working outward, pushing out any air pockets. Finally, focus on corners and edges to make sure the entire decal sticks securely in place.


